



Free Spirit Amigurumi Long Tunic

baw 7-18-2009

Materials:

- size 10 crochet cotton, rose
- size 5 steel hook or size need to achieve gauge
- four 1/4" buttons

Gauge: 8sc = 1 inch

1 Rib = two rows of sc worked in back loops only.

Link = ch3, dc in third ch from the hook

Picot = ch2, sl st in top of the last sc made

This top is worked from side to side in the back loops only (BLO). It is slightly stretchy and forgiving.

1. Ch19, sc in second ch from hook and each ch across, ch1, turn. 18sc
- 2-40. Working in BLO, sc in each sc across, ch1, turn. 18 sc

Turn the work so you are now working across the bottom of the bodice. Work three sc in the first rib, then work (three sc in the end of the next rib, 2sc in the end of the next rib) across, finishing with three sc in the last rib. ch3. 52 sc

Turn the work so you are now working up the side of the bodice in the beginning chains. Skip the first two ch, sl st in the next six ch, ch3, skip next two ch, sl st in the next six ch, ch3, skip next two ch, sl st in the last ch. Ch1.

Turn the work so you are now working across the top of the bodice. In the end of each rib work two sc. 40 sc., ch1, turn.

Neck Edge:

- 1: Sc in next six sc, work four links, skip next seven sc, join with a sc in next sc, sc in next 13 sc, work four links, skip seven sc, sc in remaining six sc.
- 2: Ch4, trc in next five sc, one trc in each link across top of arm, trc in next five sc, (trc decrease across next four stitches by working one half of the decrease, skip next two sc, work second half of decrease in next sc) trc in next five sc, one trc in each link across top of arm, trc in last six sc. Ch3
- 3: Work fpdc around each trc across. At the end work one button hole loop by working ch3, sl st in base of the dc just made. Finish off.

Bottom edge:

- 1: With wrong side facing, join with sc in first sc at bottom of tunic, sc in next three sc, ch5 (skip next 3 sc, sc in next 7 sc, ch5) across to the last 7 sc, skip next 3 sc, sc in last 4 sc, ch1, turn.
- 2: Sc in first 3 sc, ch4, sc in next ch5 space, ch4, (skip next sc, sc in next 5 sc, ch4, sc in next ch5 space, ch4) across to the last 4 sc, skip next sc, sc in last 3 sc. Ch1, turn.
- 3: Sc in first 2 sc, ch4, (sc in next ch4 sp, ch4) twice, [skip next sc, sc in next 3 sc, ch4, (sc in next ch4 space, ch4)twice] across to last 3 sc, skip next sc, sc in last 2 sc. Ch1, turn.
- 4: Sc in first sc, [ch4, (sc in next ch4 space, ch4) 3 times, skip next sc, sc in next sc) across. Finish off.

Sleeve:

1. Join with sc in side of sc at edge of armhole opening. Work another sc in side of armhole, work 3sc in each link across the top of the armhole opening, work sc in side of next sc, work sc in first sc under arm, ch1, turn. 16 sc,
2. Sc in each sc across, sc in next sc of underarm, ch1, turn. 17 sc
- 3-7. Repeat row 2. At the end of row 7 you should have 22 sc, join, ch1, turn.
- 8-17. Sc in each sc across, join, ch1, turn
18. 2sc in first sc, sc in next 11 sc, 2sc in next sc, sc in remaining sc, ch1, turn.

19.(Sc in next five sc, ch5, skip next three) across. Join with sl st in first sc.

20. Sl st in next sc, ch1, sc in same st and next two sc, ch4, sc in ch5 loop, ch4, skip next sc, (sc in next three sc, skip next sc, ch4, sc in ch5 loop, ch4, skip next sc) across; join to top of first sc.

21. Sl st in the next sc, ch1, sc, picot in top of sc, [(ch4, sc in next ch4 loop, picot) twice, ch4, skip next sc, sc in next sc, picot] across. Join to top of first sc, finish off.

Sew four buttons up the back opposite the buttonhole loops.
