



Mini Free Spirit Overalls and Jumper
designed to fit over the T-shirt

baw 1-1-2010

Materials

- Size 10 crochet cotton in Main Color (MC) and Contrasting Color (CC)
- Size 5 steel hook

Gauge: 8sc = 1 inch

Link = ch3, dc in third ch from the hook

BLO = Back Loop Only

Picot = ch2, sl st in top of previous st

Overalls

1-1-2010

Starting at the neck edge with Main Color: ch2 does not count as the first dc

1: Work 15 links, ch1, turn

2: Work four sc in each link across, ch2, turn. 60 sc

3: (Dc in first five sc, two dc in next) across, ch1, turn. 70 dc

4: Armhole dividing row. Sc in next 10 dc, ch8, skip next 15 dc, sc in next 20 sc, ch8, skip next 15 dc, sc in last 10 sc, ch2, turn. 56 sts

5: Dc in each sc and ch across, ch1, turn. 56 dc

6: Sc in each dc across, ch2, turn. 56 sc

7: Repeat row 5. 56 dc

8: Repeat row 6. 56 sc

9: Repeat row 5. 56 dc At end of row 9, join to the first dc, ch1, turn

10: Repeat row 6, join to top of first sc, ch2, turn. 56 sc

11: Repeat row 5, join to top of first dc, ch1, turn.

12: Repeat row 6, join to top of first sc, ch2, turn.

13: Repeat row 5, join to top of first dc, ch4, turn.

14: Dividing row for legs. Skip first 28 dc, join in the next dc, ch1, sc in each dc and ch around, join to the first sc, ch2, turn. 32 sc

15: (Dc next two sts tog) twice, dc in remaining sc around, join, ch1,turn. 30 dc

16: Sc in each dc around, join, ch2, turn.

17: (Dc next two sts tog) twice, dc in remaining sc around, join, ch1, turn. 28 dc

18: For short overalls, change to CC and finish after this round. Sc in each dc around, join. Finish off for short overalls, or ch2,turn, for long overalls.

19: Dc in each sc around. join, ch1,turn. 28 dc

20: Sc in each dc around, join, ch2, turn. 28 sc

21: Repeat round 19. 28 dc

22: Repeat round 20. 28 sc

23: Repeat round 19, change to CC in the last st.

24: Repeat round 20. ch1, turn.

25: Sl st in each st around, join, fasten off.

With the wrong side facing, join MC in first unused st of round 13 and repeat from round 14 for second leg.

Armhole trim, with CC:

Join with sl st in fifth underarm ch, (ch1, sl st) in each ch and dc all around the sleeve opening; sl st in the first st and fasten off.

Neck ties and trim, with CC:

Ch35, with wrong side facing join with sl st in first link at neck edge. Work 4sc in first two links, 3sc in next three links, 4sc in next five links, 3sc in next three links, 4sc in last two links, sl st, ch35 fasten off.

Pockets, make two with CC:

Ch4, join to form a ring.

1: Ch5 (counts as dc, ch2), (3dc, ch2) three times in the ring, 2dc and join to the third ch of beginning ch5.

2: Sl st into the first ch2 space, (ch3, dc, ch2, 2dc) in same space, (dc in each dc across to the next ch2 space, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in ch2 space) three times, dc in remaining dc, join to the top of beginning ch3. Fasten off leaving a tail long enough to sew the pocket to the overalls.

Place the pockets where you want them of the front of the overalls and stitch them in place with a running stitch, securing the pocket at the top edges.



Jumper

designed to fit over T-shirt

Starting at the neck edge with Main Color: ch2 does not count as the first dc

1: Work 15 links, ch1, turn

2: Work four sc in each link across, ch2, turn. 60 sc

3: (Dc in first five sc, two dc in next) across, ch1, turn. 70 dc

4: Armhole dividing row. Sc in next 10 dc, ch8, skip next 15 dc, sc in next 20 sc, ch8, skip next 15 dc, sc in last 10 sc, ch2, turn. 56 sts

5: (Dc in next six, two dc in next) across, ch1, turn. 64 dc

6: Sc in each dc across, ch2, turn. 64 sc

7: Dc in each sc across, ch1, turn. 64 sc

8: Repeat row 7

9: Repeat row 8. At the end of this row, join to the first st, ch1, turn. 64 dc

10: Sc in each dc around, join, ch2, turn. 64 sc

11: Dc in each sc around, join, ch1, turn. 64 dc

12: Repeat round 10

13: Repeat round 11

- 14: Repeat round 10
- 15: Repeat round 11
- 16: Repeat round 10. At end of round 16 join CC in the last stitch, ch1, turn
- 17: In BLO, (sc, 2dc in same st, skip next st) around. Finish off.

Armhole trim, with CC:

Join with sl st in fifth underarm ch, (dc in back loop of next dc, picot, ch1) across top of armhole, dc in last dc, sl st in next ch of underarm and fasten off.

In the chains and free loops across the top of the armhole opening, (sl st, ch1) around using another contrasting color.

Neck ties and trim, with CC:

Ch35, with wrong side facing join with sl st in first link at neck edge. Work 4sc in first two links, 3sc in next three links, 4sc in next five links, 3sc in next three links, 4sc in last two links, sl st, ch35 fasten off.

Pockets, make two with CC:

Ch4, join to form a ring.

1: Ch5 (counts as dc, ch2), (3dc, ch2) three times in the ring, 2dc and join to the third ch of beginning ch5.

2: Sl st into the first ch2 space, (ch3, dc, ch2, 2dc) in same space, (dc in each dc across to the next ch2 space, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in ch2 space) three times, dc in remaining dc, join to the top of beginning ch3.

Fasten off leaving a tail long enough to sew the pocket to the overalls.

Place the pockets where you want them of the front of the jumper and stitch them in place with a running stitch around three sides, securing the pocket at the top edges.
